

## DEMI-PAIR Program

NCVE is very proud of our popular and practical Demi-Pair Program. Demi-Pair is similar to an Au-Pair except that rather than being a full-time role it is only a part-time role.

Demi-Pair students study English during the day whilst living with an Australian family; in exchange for their accommodation and meals students provide 15 hours of work per week.

A Demi-Pair is not a fully qualified nanny; however Demi-Pair students are required to have some child-minding experience.

The Demi-Pair placement is a 12-week program with an option to extend depending on the students visa conditions and overall experience with the host family. Anyone working with children in Queensland or Sydney must obtain special permission, typically in the form of a blue card or a working with children certificate. This documentation demonstrates your eligibility to work with children and may take up to two weeks to be processed. During this period, you will be expected to contribute 10 hours of housekeeping assistance to your host Demi Pair family.



20 hours of English per week\* + 15 hours of Demi-pair per weeks

\*English tuition is a separate weekly cost



Includes accommodation and all meals



Students must have a minimum English level of Intermediate
