# Late Policy

- 1. If you are 15 minutes late, you will be recorded as Late (L).
- 2. If you are more than 30 minutes late you will be recorded as Absent (A) and not allowed into class until you have permission from the Academic Manager.
- 3. If you receive 3 'Ls' in one week you will be marked as Absent (A) for 1 hour.

# Academic Progress

If your teacher considers you are not achieving satisfactory progress, that is:

- below 50% Grades D/E/F
- you are having difficulties with your studies,

They will meet with you and the Academic Manager to talk about how the College can support you in your studies, which will include:

- Setting out a plan of work to achieve your goals.
- The College will do everything it can to help you with your studies.

However, if you do not achieve satisfactory progress, below 50% - Grades D/E/F, after receiving help from the college, we must report this to the Australian Government.
